On July 19, 2012, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 14, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and termination of the requirement for quarterly supervisor reports. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol tests is GRANTED. The frequency is hereby reduced to 28 urine screens per year and an annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for termination of the requirement for quarterly supervisor reports is hereby DENIED. Respondent must practice under the current conditions of the Order before the Board will consider amending additional requirements.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
