On September 12, 2012, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On June 3, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for an increase in PIC hours and a reduction of drug and alcohol screens to 12 per year and one annual hair test. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens to 12 per year and one annual hair test is denied. Instead, the Board GRANTS a reduction in drug and alcohol screens to 28 per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for increased PIC hours is DENIED because Respondent is not currently working as a pharmacist and has not been compliant with the terms of the Order
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
