On September 13, 2012, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 12, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for reduction in drug screens, reduction on AA/NA meetings and access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for reduction in drug screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent is required to have 14 drug screens per year and one annual hair sample while respondent is not working as a nurse. The Board reserves the right to increase drug, alcohol, and hair testing once the Respondent obtains employment as a nurse.

2. Respondent's request for reduction in AA/NA meetings is hereby GRANTED. Respondent is required to attend one AA/NA meeting per week.

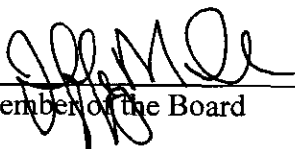
3. Respondent's request for access to controlled substances is hereby DENIED. Respondent needs to practice nursing under the current conditions of the Board Order.

4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
