On November 1, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") removed Respondent's stay of suspension for violation of the Final Decision and Order dated November 14, 2012 ("Order"). Respondent may petition the Board for reinstatement of the stay upon demonstrating continuous compliance with the Order for at least the most recent three months.

On March 18, 2015, Respondent petitioned the board for the following modifications of the Order including: termination of the AA/NA requirement; to attend therapy as recommended by his treatment provider; and a full license. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for modifications of the Order is GRANTED as follows:
 - a. The request to eliminate attendance at AA/NA meetings is GRANTED.
 - b. The request to attend therapy as recommended by treatment provider is GRANTED.
 - c. The request for a full unlimited license is DENIED. Reason for denial is failure to maintain full compliance with the Board Order for five (5) years.
2. All other terms of the Order not otherwise modified remain in effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
