On December 6, 2012, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 8, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a permanent reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby DENIED. Respondent must practice nursing under the current conditions of the Order before the Board will consider further permanent reductions.

2. The Board hereby GRANTS a temporary reduction in drug and alcohol screens. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 14 urine screens per year and one annual hair test while Respondent is not working as a nurse. The Board reserves the right to increase drug, alcohol, and/or hair testing once Respondent obtains nursing employment.

3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.

4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
