On August 14, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 20, 2015 the Respondent appeared before the Medical Examining Board and requested to be allowed to work in a setting where he has access to controlled substances. The Board considered Respondent's request to be allowed to work in a setting where he has access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request to be allowed to work in a setting where he has access to controlled substances is hereby DENIED due to the seriousness of the facts underlying the issuance of the order. The Board will not consider further petitions prior to May 20, 2016, as the Respondent must demonstrate further full compliance under the terms of the Order.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
