On July 13, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice as a physician assistant for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On February 18, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for reduction in the number of drug and alcohol screens and also to be allowed to work in a setting where she has access to controlled substances. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

- 1. Respondent's request for reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. The Respondent is now required to test at a rate of no less than thirty-six (36) times per year and one annual hair test.
- 2. Respondent's request to be allowed to work in a setting where she has access to controlled substances is hereby DENIED. Reason for denial: Further compliance under the Order is required before additional modifications will be considered.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
 - 4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
