On September 18, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On August 19, 2015, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request to reduce the required number of drug and alcohol screens from 36 (thirty six) times per year to 24 (twenty four). Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request to reduce drug screens from thirty six (36) times per year to twenty four (24) is DENIED as Respondent has failed to demonstrate sufficient time in compliance with the Order.
