On July 17, 2013, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacy license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 18, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for pharmacist in charge (PIC) hours, elimination of NA/AA meetings, termination of alcohol restriction, and reduction of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's requests for PIC hours, elimination of NA/AA meetings, termination of alcohol restriction, and reduction of drug and alcohol screens are hereby DENIED per the Order as the Respondent may only petition the Board for modifications on an annual basis. See Section D.5. Future petitions for PIC hours shall include evidence of current employment as a pharmacist.
