On October 10, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 8, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens, reduction in AA/NA meetings, termination of AODA treatment, and access to controlled substances in the workplace. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 36 urine screens and one hair test per year.
2. Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meeting attendance is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to one meeting per week.
3. Respondent's request for termination of AODA treatment is hereby GRANTED.
4. Respondent's request for access to controlled substances is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time of compliance under the terms of the Order.
5. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
6. This order is effective the date of its signing.
