On December 19, 2013, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions for at least two years.

Information submitted in support of Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol tests has been reviewed. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent is eligible for a temporary reduction at this time, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol tests is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to five (5) tests per year until she obtains employment as a nurse, at which time the frequency will return to not less than ten (10) tests per year.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
