On February 6, 2014, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete 40 hours of education in accordance with the continuing education requirements specified in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 135.02 within 90 days. On November 3, 2014, Respondent's home inspector credential was suspended for failure to complete the education as ordered.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension is terminated and Respondent's home inspector credential (#370-106) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
