On February 12, 2014, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacy license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

Information has been received that demonstrates Respondent is in violation of the terms of the Order and, as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The stay of suspension is removed and Respondent's pharmacy license (#15298-40) is hereby SUSPENDED until further notice.
2. Respondent may petition the Board or its designee for reinstatement of the stay upon demonstrating continuous compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order for at least the most recent three (3) months.
3. This order is effective immediately.
