On July 16, 2014, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On June 17, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request to be allowed to provide patient care. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request to be allowed to provide patient care is hereby DENIED due to failure to comply with the terms of the Order. The respondent did not obtain an AODA assessment by a pre-approved AODA assessor at a facility acceptable to the Board.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
