On April 10, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions. Requirements of the Order include the submission of quarterly work reports from Respondent's nursing employers for a period of at least two (2) years. Respondent may petition the Board for termination of this limitation after working as a nurse for one (1) year, which the Board may grant or deny in its discretion.

On October 8, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for termination of the limitation and the return of her license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her professional nursing license to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED due to insufficient time to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance under the terms of the Order.
2. This order is effective the date of its signing.
