
On May 8, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions. Respondent was also required to pay \$1,300 in costs of the proceeding within 12 months pursuant to the Order.

On May 14, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and extension of the deadline to pay the costs of the proceeding. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 28 per year and one annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for an extension of the deadline to pay the costs of the proceeding is hereby GRANTED. Respondent is given until November 30, 2015 to pay the balance in full.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
