On June 2, 2014, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete 16 hours of education in accordance with the continuing education requirements specified in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 125.02 within 180 days. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the education requirements and as a result the following is entered:
