On June 12, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to pay \$895.00 in costs of the proceeding within 180 days from the date of the Order and complete three (3) hours of pre-approved education in medication administration and documentation and three (3) hours of pre-approved education in ethics within 90 days from the date of the Order.

The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding and to complete the education requirements. Therefore, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's practical nursing license in the state of Wisconsin (#313284-31) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has paid the costs of the proceeding in full and has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
