
On July 9, 2014, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice dentistry. Respondent was required to complete four (4) hours of education in treatment planning and eight (8) hours of education in operative or restorative dentistry with a clinical component pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's license to practice dentistry (#6661-15) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
