On July 30, 2014, the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's veterinary license. Respondent was required to complete three (3) hours of education in ethics and three (3) hours of education in side-effects of medication within 90 days and twenty-six (26) hours of education to fulfill the continuing education requirements of the previous biennium within 180 days pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's veterinary license (#3859-50) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
