FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On or about August 27, 2014, the Wisconsin Psychology Examining Board (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order (Order) suspending Respondent's psychologist license (# 2018-57) for an indefinite period. The Order provided Respondent with the opportunity to be granted a stay of suspension and to practice under the terms and conditions specified in the Order.
- 2. On or about April 6, 2015, Respondent petitioned the Board for a stay of the suspension. The stay was granted.
- 3. On or about June 18, 2015, the Board received information that demonstrated Respondent was in violation of the terms of the Order and removed the stay of suspension.
- 4. On or about July 30, 2015, Respondent contacted the Department Monitor and requested that he be allowed to voluntarily surrender his Wisconsin Psychologist license.
- 5. As of the date of this order, a check of the Department of Safety and Professional Services records show that Respondent does not have any complaints or other disciplinary actions pending.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Psychology Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 440.19 and 455.09, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. The voluntary SURRENDER of the license to practice psychology in the state of Wisconsin issued to BRIAN MAMOTT (license #2018-57) is hereby accepted.
- 3. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement or licensure as a Psychologist, the Board may enter an order denying such petition without further notice

or hearing. Whether to grant a license and whether to impose any limitations or restrictions on any license shall be in the discretion of the Board.

4. Respondent shall immediately return all indicia of Wisconsin Psychologist licensure to the Department Monitor at the address below:
