On September 8, 2014, the Professional Counselor Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Worker Examining Board issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the Board ordered that pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 440.22, the costs of this proceeding be assessed against Respondent. The Board received the Affidavits of costs from the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and Division of Hearings and Appeals. The Board considered the Affidavits of Costs on August 11, 2015, and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 440.22, that seventy-five percent of the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$3,501.44 are hereby assessed against Respondent, and shall be payable by Respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services. **Failure of Respondent to make payment on or before August 11, 2016, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless the Respondent petitions for and the Board grants a different deadline.** Under Wis. Stats. § 440.22(3), the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the Respondent until the Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
