On October 9, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete six (6) hours of education in medication administration within six (6) months. On April 13, 2015, Respondent's professional nursing license was suspended for failure to complete the education as ordered.
