On October 9, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license and advanced practice nurse prescriber license. Respondent was required to complete 23 hours of education in professional boundaries and 25 hours of education in appropriate prescribing of controlled substances pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#79909-30) and advanced practice nurse prescriber license (#3319-33) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credentials are removed.
