On October, 28, 2014, the Wisconsin Social Worker Section ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to pay \$128.91 in costs of the proceeding and complete 24 hours of education in subject matter relevant to the practice of social work, both within 90 days from the date of the Order.

The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding and to complete the education requirements. Therefore, the following is entered:

1. Respondent's social worker certificate (#5491-120) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has paid the costs of the proceeding in full and has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
