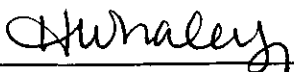
On November 12, 2014, the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's residential appraiser certification. Respondent was required to complete 15 hours of education in USPAP and 30 hours of education in residential sales comparison and income approach pursuant to the terms of the Order.
