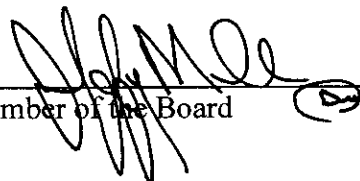
On November 13, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 12, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for restoration to full, unrestricted licensure, or in the alternative, a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for restoration to full, unrestricted licensure is hereby DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance with the terms of the Order
2. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is also DENIED. Respondent needs to fully comply with the complete terms and conditions of the Order.
