
On November 25, 2014, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (“Department”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) requiring Respondent to pay \$505.00 in costs of the proceeding within 90 days. On March 19, 2015, Respondent’s private security person permit was suspended for failure to pay the costs of the proceeding as ordered.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now paid the costs of the proceeding in full, the following is entered:

1. The suspension is terminated and Respondent’s private security person permit (#46103-108) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
