On January 21, 2015, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in that she shall not provide medical care during labor and delivery, without the concurrent attendance of an obstetrician certified by the American Board of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, except in a bona fide medical emergency.

On March 18, 2015, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full, unrestricted licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery (#40511-20) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are hereby removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
