The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Social Worker Section of the Wisconsin Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board (Section). The Section has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Section in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Clare M. Weber (DOB February 14, 1951) is certified in the state of Wisconsin to practice social work, having certificate number 360-120, first granted on August 2, 1993, and current through February 28, 2015. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 345 Gifford Court, Nekoosa, Wisconsin 54457.

2. In 2013, the Department of Safety and Professional Services commenced an audit of compliance with the continuing education requirements for social workers for the 2011-2013 biennium.

3. Respondent's name was randomly selected as a subject of the audit.

4. Respondent certified on her 2013 application for certificate renewal that she completed thirty (30) hours of continuing education for the 2011-2013 biennium.

5. Respondent did not request and was not granted a postponement or waiver of the social worker continuing education requirements for the 2011-2013 biennium.

6. When Respondent was contacted pursuant to the audit, she indicated that she wished to voluntarily surrender her license due to retirement.

7. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Social Worker Section of the Wisconsin Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 457.26(2), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. Respondent violated Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 8.02(1), by failing to complete 30 credits of continuing education in the appropriate biennium.

3. Respondent, in failing to comply with the requirements of Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 8.02(1), has engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § 20.02(2).

4. Respondent violated Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 8.02(1)(b), by failing to complete at least four (4) of the thirty (30) required continuing education hours in the subject area of social work ethics and boundaries.

5. Respondent, in failing to comply with the requirements of Wis. Admin. Code § 8.02(1)(b), has engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 20.02(2).

6. As a result of the above violation(s), Clare M. Weber is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 457.26(2)(h).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
2. The voluntary SURRENDER of the certificate to practice social work in the State of Wisconsin issued to Clare M. Weber, (certificate no. 360-120) is hereby accepted.
3. Respondent shall not use any social worker title unless and until she is granted recertification under the terms set out in paragraphs 4 & 5 below.
4. Respondent shall not petition for recertification for a period of one (1) year following the date of this order.
5. Before Respondent may petition for recertification, Respondent shall first satisfy the Section or its designee that she has complied with the following:
 - a. Respondent shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$100.00, before any such application may be considered.
 - b. Respondent shall successfully complete 30 hours of continuing education for each biennium from 2011-13 through the biennium in which Respondent seeks recertification. Continuing education accomplished pursuant to this paragraph shall comply with the requirements specified in Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 8.02.
 - c. Respondent shall submit proof, satisfactory to the Section or its designee, of the successful completion of the education.
 - d. The education completed pursuant to this limitation may not be used to satisfy any other continuing education requirements that have been or may be instituted by the Section or Department.
 - e. Respondent shall submit a petition for recertification and meet all requirements for certification existing at the time of the application.
 - f. Whether to grant recertification shall be in the discretion of the Section. The Section may, in its discretion impose such limitations as it deems advisable.
 - g. The decision of whether or not to grant recertification is within the Section's sole discretion and is not reviewable.
6. Proof of successful course completion and payment of costs (made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services) shall be sent by Respondent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

7. Violation of any terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a revocation of Respondent's right to reapply for certification. The Section in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order.

8. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

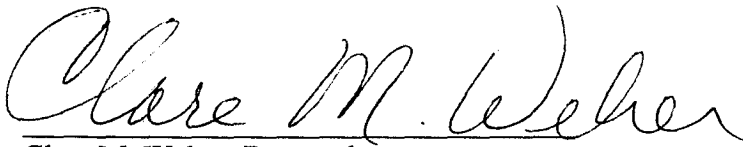

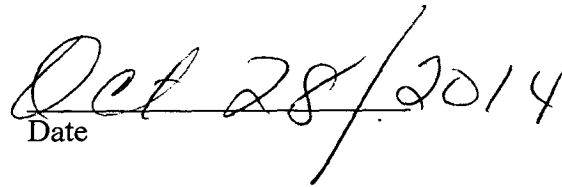

The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Section ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Section in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Section may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Section should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Section adopt this Stipulation, the Section's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.

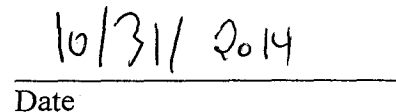
8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Section adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
