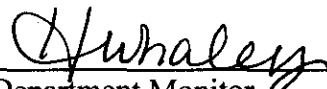
On January 28, 2015, the Wisconsin Veterinary Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's veterinary medicine license. Respondent was required to complete three (3) hours of education in record keeping pursuant to the terms of the Order.
