FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jacqueline Geske (Applicant) has applied for licensure as a Registered Nurse in the State of Wisconsin.
2. Applicant's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services is 46 E. High Street, Milton, WI 53563.
3. Applicant is currently licensed in the State of Michigan as a Registered Nurse.
4. On or about April 4, 2013, Applicant was found to be negligent for administering medication contrary to a physician's order by the Michigan Board of Nursing.
5. On or about April 4, 2013, the Michigan Board of Nursing placed Applicant's license on probation.
6. Applicant's license as a Registered Nurse is currently on probation in Michigan.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Applicant violated Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.03(1)(b). As such, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board) has grounds to deny Applicant's application for licensure as a Registered Nurse, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07 (1g).

2. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 15.02(5)(c) and 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that JACQUELINE GESKE is GRANTED a LICENSE AS A REGISTERED NURSE subject to the following LIMITATIONS, TERMS, AND CONDITIONS.

CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS

Practice Limitations

- A.1. Applicant shall practice only under the direct supervision of a licensed nurse or other licensed health care professional.
- A.2. Applicant shall provide a copy of this Order, the Disciplinary Order from the Michigan Board of Nursing and all other subsequent Orders to supervisory personnel at all settings where Applicant works as a nurse or care giver or provides health care, currently or in the future, during the duration of the limited license.
- A.3. It is Applicant's responsibility to arrange for written reports from supervisors to be provided to the Department Monitor on a quarterly basis, as directed by the Department Monitor. These reports shall assess Applicant's work performance, ability to follow orders, ability to administer medication as prescribed and shall include the number of hours of active nursing practice worked during that quarter.
- A.4. Applicant shall report to the Board any change of employment status, residence, address or telephone number within five (5) days of the date of a change.

Required Reporting by Applicant

- B.2. Applicant is responsible for compliance with all of the terms and conditions of this Order, including the timely submission of reports by others. Applicant shall

promptly notify the Department Monitor of any violations of any of the terms and conditions of this Order by Applicant.

- B.3. Every three (3) months the Applicant shall notify the Department Monitor of the Applicant's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, and shall provide the Department Monitor with a current address and home telephone number.

Petitions for Modification of Limitations or Termination of Order

- B.4. Applicant may petition the Board on an annual basis for modification of the terms of this Order, starting after one full year of compliance with this Order. Compliance with this Order includes, but is not limited to, written work reports as required via A.3., acceptable to the Board.
- B.5. Applicant may petition the Board for full licensure after two full years of compliance with this Order.
- B.6. Denial of a petition in whole or in part shall not be considered a denial of a license within the meaning of Wis. Stat. § 227.01(3)(a), and Applicant shall not have a right to any further hearings or proceedings on the denial.

Costs of Compliance

- B.7. Applicant shall be responsible for all costs and expenses incurred in conjunction with the monitoring, supervision and any other expenses associated with compliance with the terms of this Order.

Additional Discipline

- B.8. Violation of any terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Applicant's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event that Applicant fails to submit reports as ordered, Applicant's license may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Applicant has complied with the terms of this order.

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
STIPULATION


