FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Nicole Wilburn (Applicant) has applied for licensure as a Licensed Practical Nurse in the State of Wisconsin.
2. Applicant's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services is 312 N. 75th St. #2, Milwaukee, WI 53213.
3. The Board of Nursing (Board) denied Applicant's application for licensure on July 17, 2014.
4. Applicant filed a request for hearing concerning the denial of her application.
5. In resolution of the Applicant's request for hearing, the Board offered and the Applicant accepted a Limited License as a Practical Nurse, subject to specific terms and conditions.
6. The Applicant withdraws her request for hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 15.08(5)(c) and 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, that NICOLE WILBURN is GRANTED a LIMITED LICENSE AS A PRACTICAL NURSE subject to the following LIMITATIONS.

CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS

Practice Limitations

- A.1. Applicant shall provide a copy of this Order and all other subsequent Orders to her employer's human resources department and her direct supervisor at all settings where Applicant works as a nurse or care giver or provides health care, currently or in the future, during the duration of the limited license.
- A.2. It is Applicant's responsibility to arrange for written reports from her direct supervisor to be provided to the Department Monitor on a quarterly basis, as directed by the Department Monitor. These reports shall assess Applicant's work performance, ability to follow orders, ability to administer medication as prescribed and shall include the number of hours of active nursing practice worked during that quarter.
- A.3. Applicant shall report to the Board any change of employment status, residence, address or telephone number within five (5) days of the date of a change.

Required Reporting by Applicant

- B.2. Applicant is responsible for compliance with all of the terms and conditions of this Order, including the timely submission of reports by others. Applicant shall promptly notify the Department Monitor of any violations of any of the terms and conditions of this Order by Applicant.
- B.3. Every three (3) months the Applicant shall notify the Department Monitor of the Applicant's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, and shall

provide the Department Monitor with a current address and home telephone number.

- B.4. Applicant must report any new charges (ordinance, misdemeanors, and felonies) to the Department Monitor within 48 hours of receiving the citation.

Petitions for Modification of Limitations or Termination of Order

- B.5. Applicant may petition the Board on an annual basis for modification of the terms of this Order, beginning after one full year of compliance with the Order. The Board may grant such petition upon Applicant's showing of successful, continuous compliance with this Order. Successful, continuous compliance includes submission of positive work reports, acceptable to the Board.
- B.6. Applicant may petition the Board for full licensure after two full years of successful, continuous compliance with this Order.
- B.7. Denial of a petition in whole or in part shall not be considered a denial of a license within the meaning of Wis. Stat. § 227.01(3)(a), and Applicant shall not have a right to any further hearings or proceedings on the denial.


Costs of Compliance

- B.8. Applicant shall be responsible for all costs and expenses incurred in conjunction with the monitoring, supervision and any other expenses associated with compliance with the terms of this Order.

Additional Discipline

- B.9. Violation of any terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Applicant's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event that Applicant fails to submit reports as ordered, Applicant's license may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Applicant has complied with the terms of this order.




It is hereby stipulated between the above-referenced Applicant and the Board of Nursing (Board) as follows:
