On February 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license with certain terms and conditions. On August 19, 2015, Respondent's license was suspended for violation of the Order when she was found to have access to controlled substances while practicing.
