On February 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license and advance practice nurse prescriber certification. Respondent was required to complete five (5) hours of education in professional accountability, three (3) hours of education in scope of nursing practice and three (3) hours of education in precedex pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:
