The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Licensee Susan M. Burkheimer, L.P.N., (dob September 7, 1968) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a practical nurse, having license number 301997-31, first issued on March 12, 1999 and current through April 30, 2015. Licensee's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 6429 Pennycook Road, Edgerton, Wisconsin 53534.
- 2. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Licensee was employed as a practical nurse at a health and rehabilitation center (Center), located in Beloit, Wisconsin.

- 3. On October 1, 2014, Licensee was observing a Certified Medication Aide (CMA) conduct a medication pass.
- 4. During the medication pass, Patient A asked the CMA several questions regarding the medication. When Licensee and the CMA were unable to answer one of Patient A's questions, they informed her that
 - a. She could take the pill now and they would go get the information and be right back; or,
 - b. She could give the CMA the pill back and the CMA would go obtain the information and be right back with the answer as well as the pill to administer.
- 5. Patient A became agitated and did not understand that they could not leave Patient A with the medication unobserved.
- 6. Despite the CMA and Licensee's attempts to deescalate the situation, Patient A's agitation escalated and Licensee made the statement, "makes you want to gouge your eyes out with a spoon doesn't it?" to the CMA, out of frustration with Resident A's behavior.
- 7. Resident A overheard the comment and believed it was directed towards her; and as a result felt threatened and hurt.
- 8. Licensee and the CMA explained to Resident A that the comment was not directed towards her.
- 9. The Center conducted an investigation which determined that several witnesses corroborated Licensee's claim that the comment was not directed towards Resident A and Resident A did not claim abuse or neglect by Licensee.
 - 10. Licensee understands that this statement should not have been made.
- 11. In resolution of this matter, Licensee consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

- 2. Within six (6) months of the date of this Order, Susan M. Burkheimer, L.P.N., shall at her own expense take and successfully complete three (3) hours of education on the topic of ethics and professionalism in nursing; three (3) hours of education on the topic of dealing with difficult patients; and three (3) hours of education on patient abuse and as follows:
 - a. Each course attended in satisfaction of this Order must be preapproved by the Board or its designee. Licensee shall be responsible for locating course(s) satisfactory to the Board and for obtaining the required approval of the courses from the Board or its designee. Licensee must take and pass any exam offered for the course(s).
 - b. Licensee shall submit proof of successful completion of the education in the form of verification from the institution providing the education to the Department Monitor at the address stated below. None of the education completed pursuant to this requirement may be used to satisfy any education requirements that have been or may be instituted by the Board or Department.
- 3. Within 120 days from the date of this Order, Licensee shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$150.00.
- 4. Request of approval of courses, proof of successful course completion and payment of costs (made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services) shall be sent by Licensee to the Department Monitor at the address below:

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Licensee's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Licensee fails to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered or fails to submit proof of successful completion of the ordered education as set forth above, Licensee's license (no. 301997-31) may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Licensee has complied with payment of the costs and submitted proof of successful completion of the ordered education.

Licensee Susan M. Burkheimer, L.P.N., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services, stipulate as follows:

- 1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Licensee consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.
- 2. Licensee understands that by signing this Stipulation, Licensee voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:
 - the right to a hearing on the allegations against Licensee, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
 - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Licensee;
 - the right to call witnesses on Licensee's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
 - the right to testify on Licensee's own behalf;
 - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
 - the right to petition for rehearing; and
 - all other applicable rights afforded to Licensee under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
- 3. Licensee is aware of Licensee's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.
- 4. Licensee agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Licensee waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.
- 5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In

the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

- 6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Licensee, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
- 7. Licensee is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.
- 8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Licensee in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
