On March 5, 2015, the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's chiropractic license. Respondent was required to provide written notice to various parties explaining that Respondent was not authorized to practice chiropractic or charge any fee during the period in which his license was expired (December 15, 2012 through January 14, 2013).


Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed all limitation requirements pursuant to the Order and as a result the following is entered:

1. All limitations are removed and Respondent's chiropractic license (#4012-12) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
