On March 12, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent may petition for a stay of suspension upon providing proof that he has been in compliance with Sections C and D of this Order for the most recent three (3) consecutive months.
