On March 18, 2015, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent may petition for a stay of suspension upon providing proof which is determined by the Board or its designee to be sufficient, that Respondent has been in compliance with the provisions of Sections C and D of the Order, and that Respondent's Treater is of the opinion that Respondent is able to safely practice medicine and surgery under the restrictions of the Order.

Respondent's petition for an initial stay of suspension has been reviewed pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent qualifies for a stay of suspension at this time, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent's medicine and surgery license (#26410-20) is hereby STAYED.
2. The stay is continuous, contingent upon Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
