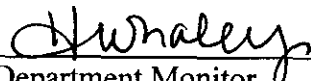
On March 18, 2015, the Social Worker Section of the Wisconsin Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board ("Section") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's social worker certification. Respondent was required to complete 22 hours of education in subject matter relevant to social work including four (4) hours of ethics and boundaries pursuant to the terms of the Order.
