PROCEDURAL HISTORY

This matter comes before the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board (Board) as a citation to which Respondent Daniela Samara has made no timely response. Based on the record in this case, the Board adopts as its Final Decision in this matter the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Respondent Daniela Samara (dob: 1/5/1970) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin 1. as a cosmetology practitioner, having license number 78924-82, first issued on December 8, 1999 and current through March 31, 2015. Respondent Daniela Samara's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 303 Park Street, Apt. 6, Fort Atkinson, Wisconsin 53538.
- On May 1, 2013, Respondent telephoned the Department and reported that she was operating her establishment and working in her establishment, even though the establishment's license had expired on April 1, 2013.

- 3. On January 21, 2015, a Division of Legal Services and Compliance (Division) investigator issued a \$250 citation to Respondent for providing cosmetology services outside a licenses establishment. Service was accomplished by mail. A true and correct copy of this citation is attached as Exhibit A and is incorporated herein by reference.
- 4. Respondent has not paid the citation that was issued to Respondent on January 21, 2015.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15.
- 2. Respondent violated Wis. Admin. Code § Cos 2.045(1) by providing cosmetology services outside a licenses establishment
- 3. As a result, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15(2)(i) and (3).
- 4. Respondent is in default pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § Cos 10.07(1) for failing to make a deposit or otherwise respond to the citation in a timely fashion.
- 5. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § Cos 10.07(1), the Board has the authority to issue an order of default against Respondent for the amount identified in the citation without further proceedings.

ORDER

- 1. Respondent is in DEFAULT and shall pay to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services a total forfeiture in the amount of \$250 within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.
