On April 8, 2015, the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") indefinitely suspending Respondent's general appraiser certification beginning 15 days after the date of the Order. The suspension shall be lifted upon submission of proof that Respondent has successfully taken and passed the AQB-approved Uniform State Certified General Real Property Appraiser Examination (Examination).

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has taken and passed the Examination, the following is entered:

1. The suspension is terminated and Respondent's general appraiser certification (#1082-10) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
