The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Jill M. Hunt, M.D. (dob June 5, 1954), is licensed in the state of Wisconsin to practice medicine and surgery, having license number 32583-20, first issued on August 22, 1991, with registration current through October 31, 2015. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 3030 Brunskill Road, Dubuque, Iowa 52003-5223.
2. Respondent also holds an active license to practice medicine in the state of Iowa, first issued there on July 22, 1980.

3. On August 8, 2014, Respondent and the Iowa Board of Medicine (Iowa Board) entered into a Statement of Charges and Settlement Agreement (Iowa Order) which sets out the following violations by Respondent between May 2009 and November 2010 while she was providing family practice care in Iowa:

a. Improper pain management by prescribing high dosages of controlled substances without appropriate evaluations; without establishing an appropriate treatment plan; in potentially harmful combinations; without appropriate precautions and consequences for diversion and/or abuse; without appropriate informed consent; without appropriate consultations or referrals; without appropriate charting; and/or without using the Prescription Drug Monitoring Database.

b. Delinquent and/or improper dictation.

4. The Iowa Order imposes the following discipline on Respondent:

a. "Citation and Warning"

b. Civil penalty of \$5,000;

c. Continuing medical education to include a chronic pain management program, a medical record-keeping program, and the Professional/Problem Based Ethics program offered by Center for Personalized Education for Physicians (CPEP);

d. A prohibition on prescribing, administering or dispensing controlled substances for the treatment of chronic pain until Respondent completes the chronic pain management program and thereafter demonstrates her competency to provide such care with reasonable skill and safety; and

e. Five years of probation to include the Iowa Board monitoring program with quarterly prescribing audits, quarterly reports and a \$300 quarterly monitoring fee, and annual appearances before the Iowa Board, or at any time upon request.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Jill M. Hunt, M.D., engaged in unprofessional conduct pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § Med 10.03(3)(c)(Oct. 2013) by having adverse action taken by an agency of another state against her license to practice medicine and surgery.

3. As a result of the above conduct, Jill M. Hunt, M.D., is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3).

ORDER


1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
2. Respondent Jill M. Hunt, M.D., is REPRIMANDED.
3. The license to practice medicine and surgery issued to Respondent Jill M. Hunt, M.D., is LIMITED, as follows:
 - a. Respondent shall maintain full and complete compliance with all terms, limitations, and conditions imposed by the Iowa Order.
 - b. For this Board's purposes, any conclusion by the Iowa Board that Respondent has violated the Iowa Order is conclusive evidence of a violation of this Order.
 - c. Respondent shall provide the Board with a copy of any document issued by the Iowa Board which alters the conditions of Respondent's continued practice of medicine and surgery in the state of Iowa, including any document advising reinstatement of full licensure.
 - d. In the event Respondent plans to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin, she shall notify the Board of her intentions and practice address at least ninety (90) days prior to her return.
 - e. Upon Respondent providing proof sufficient to the Board, or its designee, that she has successfully complied with all terms and conditions of the Iowa Order, the Board shall issue an Order removing the limitation on Respondent's license.
4. Within 90 days from the date of this Order, Jill M. Hunt, M.D., shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$305.00.
5. Payment of costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

6. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of costs as ordered, Respondent's license (32583-20) may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs.

7. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

STIPULATION

Respondent Jill M. Hunt, M.D., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.

4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division

of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.


8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
