On May 14, 2015, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete three (3) hours of education in "skin care/pressure ulcer prevention and treatment" and three (3) hours of education in "nursing delegation" within 90 days. On August 28, 2015, Respondent's license was suspended for failure to complete the education as ordered.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education, the following is entered:

1. The suspension is terminated and Respondent's license (99075-30) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
