On December 11, 2013, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") accepting Respondent's surrender of his license to practice medicine and surgery.

On December 17, 2014, the Board considered and approved Respondent's request for reinstatement of full licensure to practice medicine and surgery in Wisconsin. On December 19, 2014, Respondent received a full, unrestricted license to practice medicine and surgery. Thereafter, Respondent requested the Board affirm the granting of his full, unrestricted license by Board Order.

On March 18, 2015 the Board affirmed the granting of Respondent's full, unrestricted license.

1. The Board affirms the reinstatement of Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery, without restriction (License No. 18820-20).
