
On September 2, 2015, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete four (4) hours of education in "Record Keeping" within 90 days and four (4) hours of education in "Risk Management" within 90 days. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the education requirements and as a result the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's license to practice dentistry (#5302-15) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
