PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties have agreed to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as an Interim Order in this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Wilton C. Calderon, D.O. (dob May 29, 1970) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin to practice medicine and surgery, having license number 52734-21, first issued on March 4, 2009, with registration current through February 29, 2016. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is in Connecticut.

2. Respondent was employed as a physician in Plover, Wisconsin and practiced family medicine between 2009 and January 2015.

3. In January 2015, Respondent relocated his practice to New London, Connecticut.

4. On July 31, 2015, the Department received a complaint alleging that

a. Respondent engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code §§ Med 10.02(2)(zd) and (2)(p) (Nov. 2002); and

b. Respondent engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code §§ Med 10.03(2)(c), (2)(e) and (2)(f) (Oct. 2013).

5. The Department subsequently opened 15 MED 262 for investigation.

6. Respondent has had the opportunity to consult with counsel and denies the allegations. Respondent has voluntarily agreed not to practice as a physician in Wisconsin pending the final resolution of the Department's investigation of 15 MED 262.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).


#### ORDER


1. The Stipulation of the parties is accepted.

FOR INTERIM ORDER

Respondent Wilton Craig Calderon, D.O., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:


1. This Stipulation is entered into in the course of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance.
2. Respondent is aware of his right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation. Respondent is represented by Attorney Diane M. Welsh.
3. Respondent denies the allegations in this matter, but agrees to the adoption of the attached Interim Order by the Medical Examining Board. The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Interim Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the attached Interim Order, if adopted in the form as attached.
4. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that this Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.
5. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, and any member of the Board ever assigned as a case advisor in this investigation, may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent or Respondent's attorney, if any, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with the Board's deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such case advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Interim Order.

6. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Interim Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.


7. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending that the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Interim Order.
