On the above stated time, date and location, an investigation/inspection has disclosed the following violation, which must be corrected.

Respondent McAllister's workstation had clean equipment (scissors, curling irons and combs) sitting in the open on her workstation. McAllister also had combs, hair rollers, and miscellaneous clean equipment in drawers in a storage cabinet, but there was at least 2 inches of open space between the top and bottom of each drawer, such that the drawers did not serve as closed containers and contaminating residue could get on the equipment.
