On March 3, 2000, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 10, 2016, the Board considered Respondent's request for full, unrestricted licensure or, in the alternative, a reduction in drug and alcohol screens. Respondent appeared before the Board on behalf of her request. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for full licensure or a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is DENIED for failure to demonstrate continuous and successful compliance under the terms of the Order.
