On August 8, 2003, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her nursing license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On July 13, 2016, the Board designee considered Respondent's request to terminate the drug and alcohol treatment required pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, including a recommendation from Respondent's Treater, the following is entered:
